**Calgary District Lacrosse Association Raffle Project**

The CDLA is a non-profit organization formed under the Societies Act (Alberta) and for the past approximately 30 years has been responsible for the organization of minor box lacrosse for boys and girls between the ages of 4 and 16 years old.

CDLA fees have not kept pace with the raising costs associated with operating our league and at the present time we are experiencing a slight deficit. As you are aware the cost of participation in amateur sports continues to increase and lacrosse is no exception. Amateur sports groups can no longer run their programs on registration fees alone if they wish to keep their programs affordable and growing and must think out of the "box"..

At the November Board of Directors meeting of the CDLA it was decided that our organization would undertake a significant raffle initiative in order to provide much needed operational and special project funds. It is anticipated that we would sell approximately 25,000 – 27,500 tickets (10 per registered player). We have made arrangements with a local dealer to acquire a 2010 Buick Lacrosse at a very good price as our main raffle prize. In addition, we are discussing a number of other very exciting ideas with this sponsor which we will share with our members when the details are finalized.

The sale of raffle tickets would occur during the 2010 lacrosse season May and June and the final draw would occur at the CDLA's Canada Day Tournament. This tournament is one of the largest minor box lacrosse tournaments in Canada with over 150 teams from Ontario to British Columbia.

We would like to thank all of the CDLA families in advance for your support of this very exciting and important project.
